RE: Thursday, November 1st 2018, Raiders at 49'ers Night Game - 49er fans savage assault

Dear Mayor Gillmor,

My daughter and I attended the above November 1st, 2018 Thursday Night Game. We were sitting in Upper Section 221 near the stairway, and during the beginning of the 3rd Quarter, unfortunately, we witnessed a savage assault below us in Lower Section 119, between two (2) San Francisco 49'ers fans.

As observed in the video link of the fight, there were at least four (4) field personnel including two (2) wearing yellow jackets, and two (2) wearing red. None of these Personnel took any action to 'call ahead' or stop this fight. As two (2) of the individuals involved in the fight were slowly walking up the stairs to the shared mezzanine, and since no one else at Levi's Stadium was taking any action, I worked my way down to intercept them. There was a woman on the shared mezzanine, in Security attire, and I was yelling at the top of my lungs for her to call police and or backup. The Security woman was trying to work some sort of device, as I continued screaming for her to get backup or help. As the assailant in a red shirt and his smaller accomplice were walking across the mezzanine, I confronted the red shirt assailant and told him to stop. The assailant continued to walk toward the outer perimeter of the mezzanine deck, counterclockwise Northward toward the Exit Stairs. As my daughter and I continued to follow the two individuals, and when we reached the stairs the smaller of the two individuals wearing a dark # 80 SF 49'ers jersey, grabbed me and tried to keep me from following the assailant wearing the red shirt. I continued following both individuals down the stairs, while yelling for help, and finally convinced a 'visiting' (his words) uniformed California Highway Patrolman who was just outside the gate close to the light rail train tracks. The CHP officer grabbed the assailant wearing the red shirt, and a couple of Santa Clara Police Officers then surrounded the two individuals, and I first, and then my daughter second, gave individual accounts to one of the arresting officers.

It is my understanding there were over 400 (four hundred) combined Santa Clara Police Dept. and visiting Law Enforcement Officers, yet it took me an Oakland Raiders fan, to act solely, and insert myself and be the only line of defense in bringing the red shirted assailant to restraint and arrest.

The next day I immediately went to the Santa Clara Police Dept. to provide further information on our exact seating in addition to requesting a copy of the Police Report. As per the attachments and emails, I have visited the City of Santa Clara twice recently, along with email and verbal requests for information from the Santa Clara Police Dept., and personally delivering a hand- written note for City Attorney.

Since Saturday, November 10th, the Santa Clara Police Dept. and City Attorney Brian Doyle have 'gone dark' on me, without any further responses.

So, Mayor Gillmor and City Council Members, I am requesting your help, for an immediate meeting this week before another Levi's Stadium event or venue of any type takes place, which quite literally could be a matter of life or death, due to the lax and non-existent Security and Law Enforcement at this Levi's Stadium venue.

Please contact me, and I will immediately schedule myself to everyone's availability.
