Narrative

On 11/01/18, at approximately 1900 hours, I was assigned to a multiagency security detail at Levi Stadium, Santa Clara. I was wearing full police uniform and equipped with a body worn camera (BWC) and instructed to patrol the interior of the stadium.

At approximately 1919 hours, Landmark security personnel reported a physical altercation in the area of Section 118. I immediately responded to this area to assist.

I arrived on scene within minutes. Upon arrival I located Landmark security personnel, a male subject, ultimately identified as [REDACTED], wearing a red colored 49er jersey, and a male subject, ultimately identified as Eduardo Alcaraz (DOB [REDACTED]), wearing a black colored Raiders jersey. [REDACTED] and Alcaraz both identified themselves as victims of a battery. Further, Landmark security personnel identified both [REDACTED] and Alcaraz as victims of a battery.

I further observed [REDACTED] and Alcaraz. [REDACTED] had dried blood visible on his face, an approximately 1/2 laceration on the bridge of his nose, swelling to his left eye, and faint bruising below his left eye. It was apparent to me [REDACTED] was involved in a physical altercation. Alcaraz had dried blood visible on his hands but no visible injuries. When asked, Alcaraz stated he was not injured. Based on the presence of facial injuries on [REDACTED] I immediately summoned medical personnel to further evaluate.

I continued to converse with [REDACTED] and Alcaraz. Both subjects stated unknown male subjects within the stadium punched them in the upper torsos. Neither [REDACTED] and / or Alcaraz were able to provide a suspect description and / or identification of the outstanding suspects. When asked, neither [REDACTED] and / or Alcaraz desired prosecution for the reported battery or further assistance from law enforcement personnel.

Upon the arrival of medical personnel, [REDACTED] declined further medical evaluation. [REDACTED] repeatedly expressed his desire to leave. Based on the statements and lack of cooperation from [REDACTED] medical personnel were cancelled.
